Media Arts at the Toronto International Film Festival

Led by Media Arts assistant professor Dr. Courtney Brannon Donoghue and co-led with Dr. Jennifer Gómez Menjívar, this Global Intensive Opportunity program will take place at the Toronto International Film Festival (TIFF) in fall 2024. The program is open to Media Arts juniors, seniors, and graduate students and designed as an on-the-ground learning trip at North America's most prestigious film festival. The GIO program is a one-week trip that will provide students with hands-on experience at a major international film festival and market, including screenings, TIFF Industry conference panels, master class workshops, and networking with media professionals.
